

How to Display the Operating System and set UAC on Vista, Win 7, 8, 8.1

The purpose of this TSN is to determine operating system version and control the UAC. To display the operating system on Windows operating systems, the information must be displayed from “Computer” in the Start Menu.

The operations that follow refer to the results of mouse clicks, left or right, as described.

Left-click on the Windows start menu icon (ball with the Windows flag, image 1):

NOTE: Screens on different windows versions may differ from screens shown here.

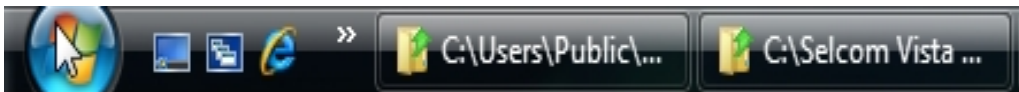

The location of “Computer” is shown in image 2:

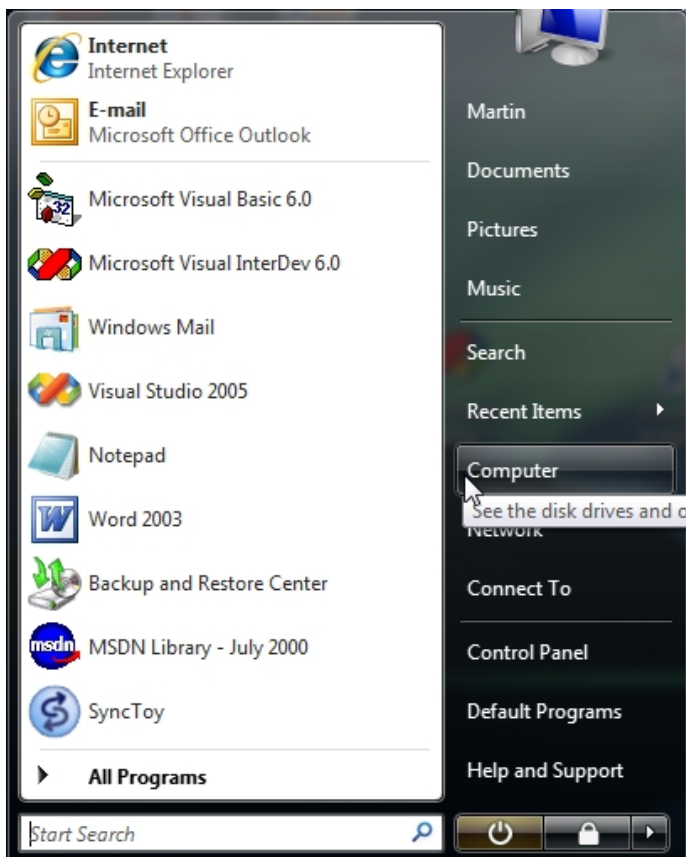

Right-click on “Computer” to bring up the context menu (as shown on image 3):

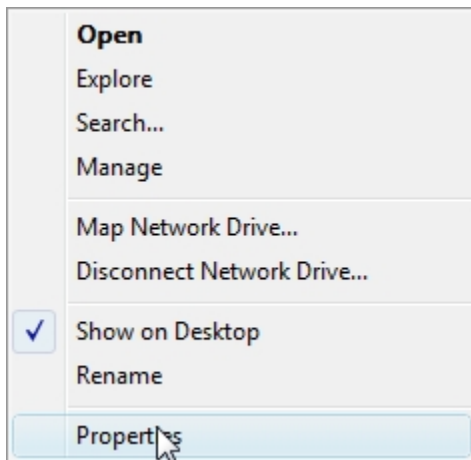

Double click on properties to display the Windows operating system (image 4).

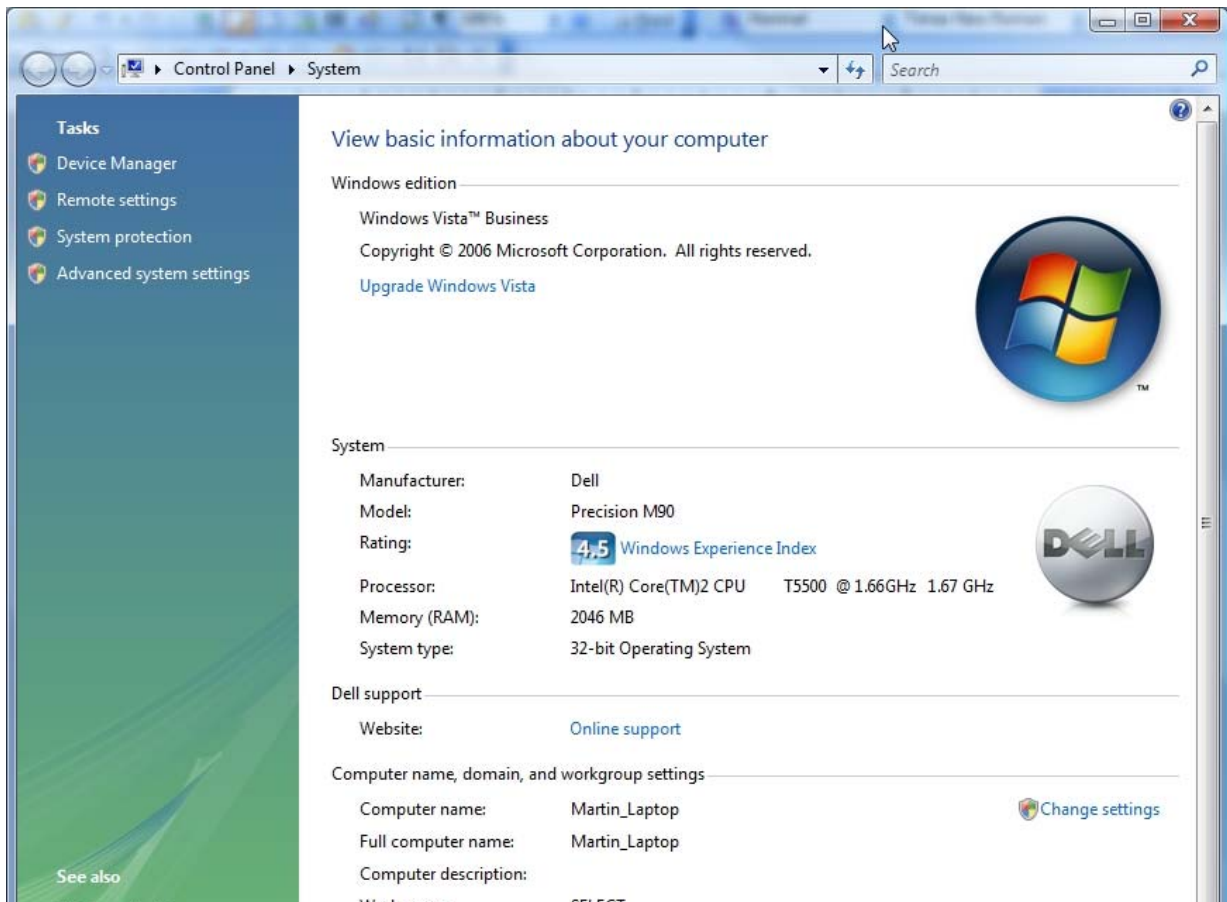

How to Display User Accounts in Windows

To display User Accounts, the information must be accessed from “Control Panel” in the Start Menu.

The operations that follow refer to the results of mouse clicks, left or right, as described.

Left-click on the Windows start menu icon (image 5):

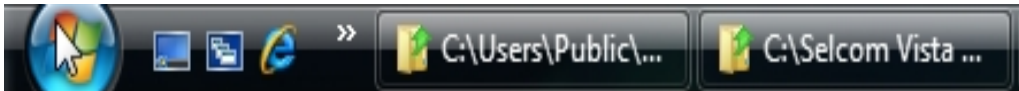

The location of “Control Panel” is shown in image 6:

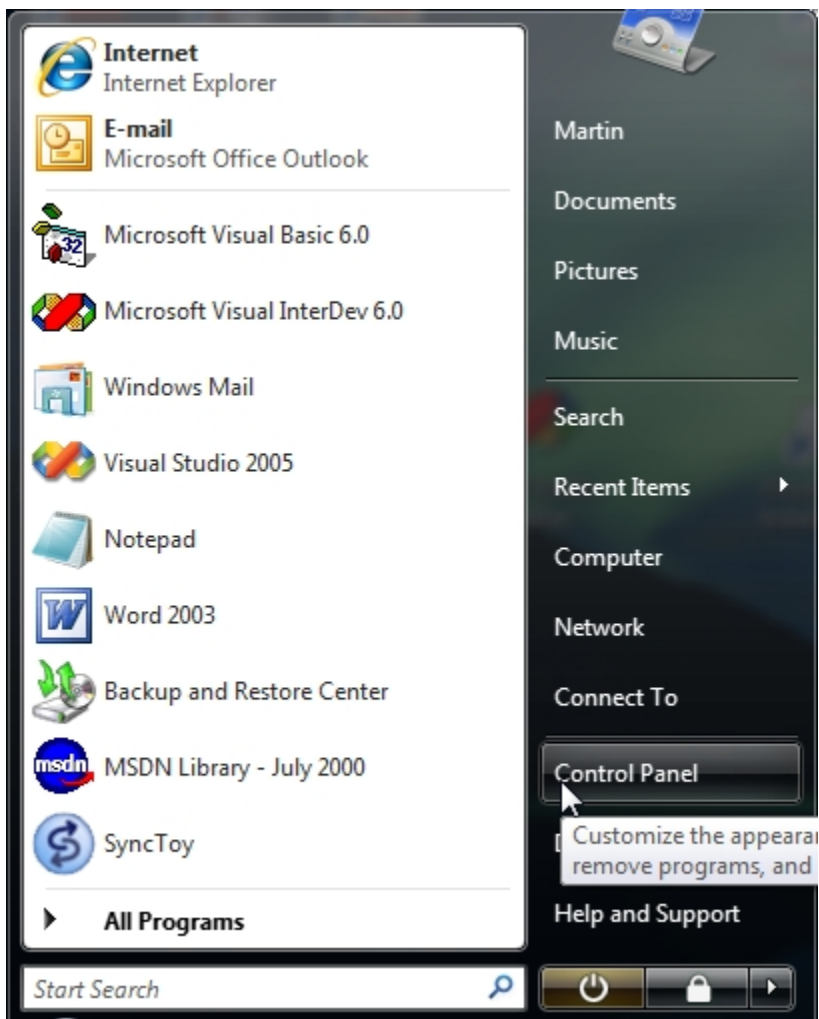

Left click on “Control Panel” to display the Control Panel options (image 7):

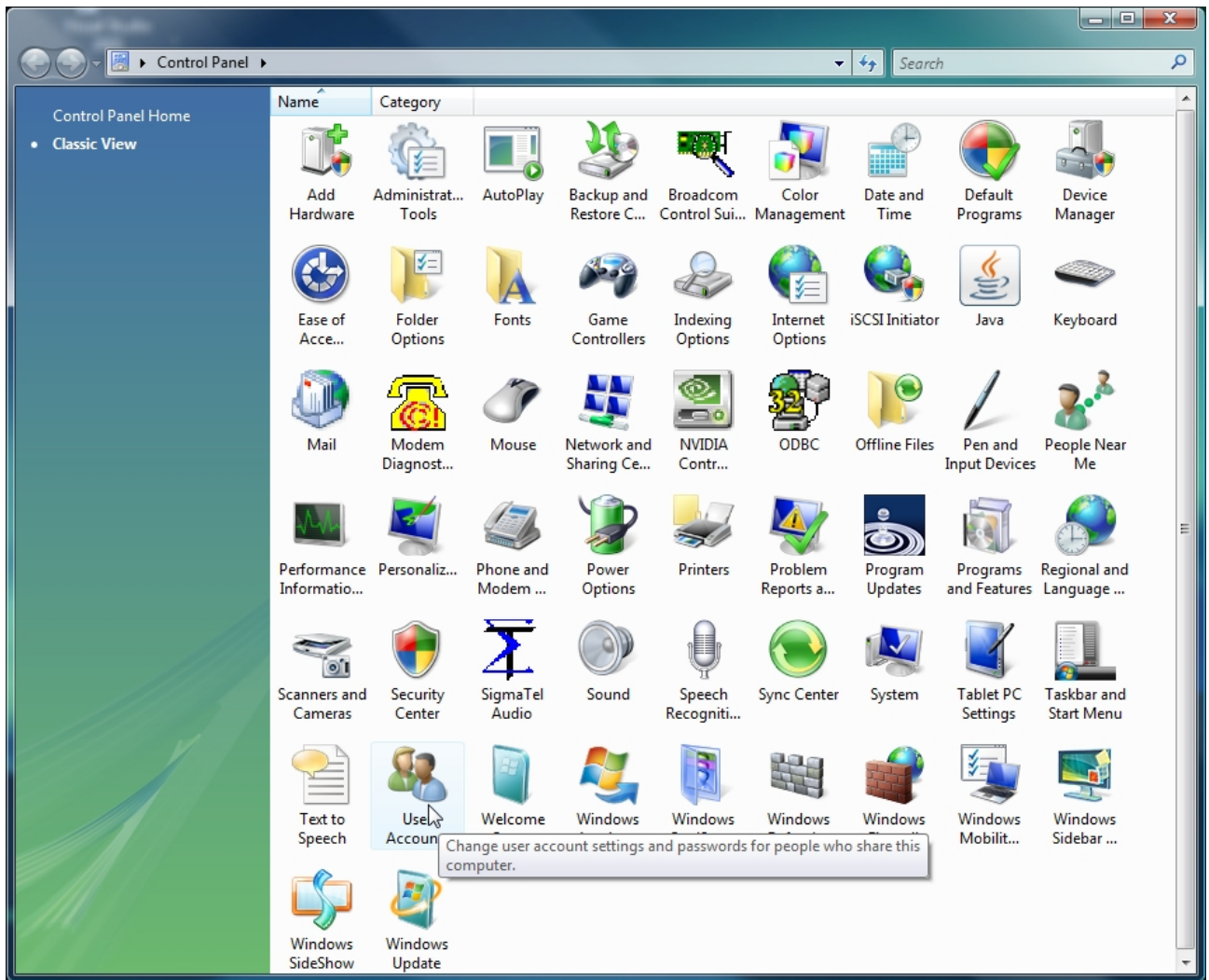
